



## What to See in the EU this October

From Tora Schultz's first solo exhibition at Palace Enterprise, Copenhagen, to a group show at Galerie Fons Welters, Amsterdam

Tora Schultz's 'DIRTY' – the artist's first solo exhibition at Copenhagen-based Palace Enterprise – speaks to gender bias by subtly reframing the tools that shape our everyday. A tower of red plastic trays, encased in a steel frame, takes centre stage. They're the kind of dishwashing racks you might find in a school canteen; yet, the highest trays of *Stratification* (2022) are too high for any kitchen worker, let alone a female worker, who is typically shorter than their male counterpart, to reach. In manipulating the tower's scale and recontextualising its humble objects, Schultz mirrors the surrealist penchant for rendering the familiar strange —
